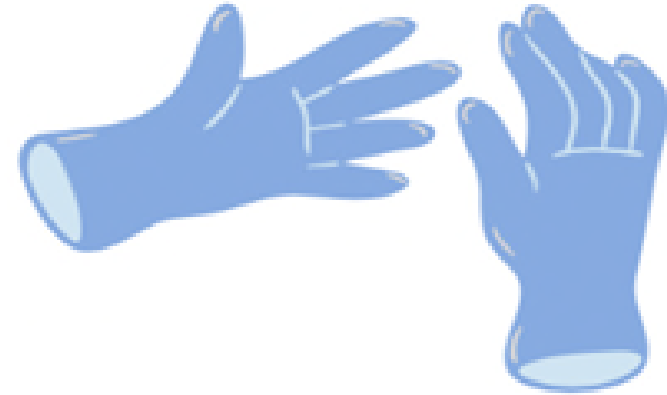
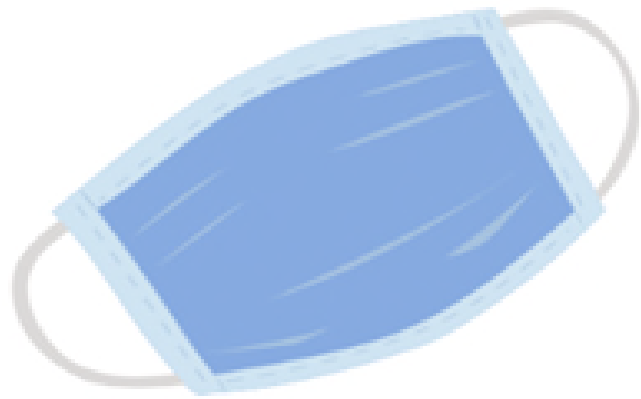




Monmouth County COVID-19 Lawn Sign
